

# How to Remove Red Candle Wax from Granite

**Q.** My granite has a red candle wax stain. What is the best way to remove the stain?

**A.** Dyes can be extremely difficult to remove, especially the red and orange colors. The dye in the wax will need a solvent to remove the stain. Clean the area with a solution of ammonia and water. This will help neutralize the dye. Create a poultice using stone poultice powder and methylene chloride.
