

## How to remove yellow stains around a bathroom vanity faucet?

**Q. What is causing the yellow staining around the faucet on my bathroom vanity? How can I prevent this from happening? How do I remove the yellow stains? Any assistance you can offer would be greatly appreciated. I'm trying to sell the house and a potential buyer does not want to replace the vanity. Thank you.**

Yellow staining around bathroom vanity faucets can be caused by a variety of factors, including hard water deposits, soap scum buildup, or mineral and product residue. How to clean and prevent these stains depends largely on what type of material your vanity top is and what is causing the stain.

For natural stone, such as marble, granite, or quartzite, use a pH-neutral cleaner specifically designed for stone. Avoid bleach or harsh chemicals, which can cause discoloration or damage. Regularly wipe the area dry to prevent water and soap buildup. Sealing the stone annually can also help inhibit staining. Note that natural stone surfaces are porous and sensitive to acidic or abrasive cleaners.

Perhaps your vanity is some other material. Here are some cleaning tips for all materials:

- Wipe down the area around faucets regularly to remove soap residue and water spots.
- Dry surfaces after use to minimize water and mineral buildup.
- Use a soft cloth or sponge for cleaning to avoid scratching.
- Avoid letting products like makeup, hair dye, or cleaners stay on the

surface.
