Acidic cleaners, like vinegar or citrus-based products, can etch or dull the surface, leaving permanent marks. Highly alkaline cleaners, including some degreasers or strong detergents, can also damage the stone or leave a hazy residue that is difficult to remove. A pH-neutral, stone-safe cleaner avoids these risks. It cleans gently, preserving the stone's existing color, finish, and texture.
