

# How to remove turmeric spice on a blue stone kitchen floor?

**Q. We spilled some turmeric spice on our blue stone kitchen floor. Any ideas on how to remove it?**

**A.** First, blot up any fresh turmeric with a soft cloth or paper towel. Avoid rubbing. It will push the staining agents deeper into the stone.

**NOTE: Follow the manufacturer's safety precautions when using chemicals.**

Mix a few drops of pH-neutral stone cleaner or gentle dish soap with warm water. Dampen a soft cloth or sponge and gently blot the stained area. Rinse with clean water and blot dry.

The yellow-orange color of turmeric comes from curcumin, a natural dye that binds to oils and fats. Here's the kicker. Turmeric powder contains natural oils that help the pigment stick.

On sealed stone, one should have a little extra time to wipe up a turmeric spill before it becomes a stain. If sealer is compromised, turmeric can get under it and into the stone. The oils in turmeric make water-based DIY cleaning less effective.

If the initial cleaning doesn't remove the spot, try this: Pour 20-50% hydrogen peroxide directly on the stain. You'll need to purchase this at a beauty supply store, because the regular drug store variety is too weak. Leave this in place until the bubbling stops. Hopefully this will remove the stain. If not, there's one more thing you can try...

Poultice with 20-50% hydrogen peroxide and poultice powder. A poultice

**CAUTION:** Do not use ammonia or alkaline type cleaners on turmeric stains as this may permanently stain the stone.
